Eco Club have been taking part in a transport survey as part of the Big Switch Off! Thank you to all those who have taken part!

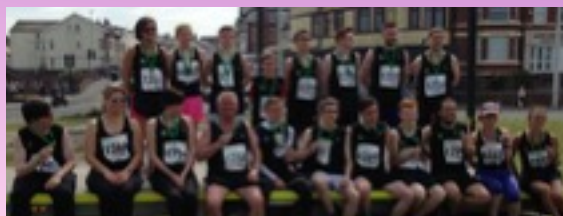

- 3F - Karl and Ryan F for excellent team work in Eco transport building.

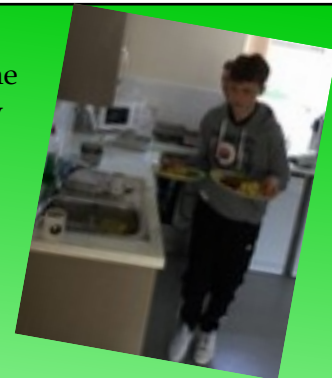
KS4/5 'Achiever of the Week'

Here is 5S making sure everyone has something to eat in the new Sixth Form Centre. Serving up



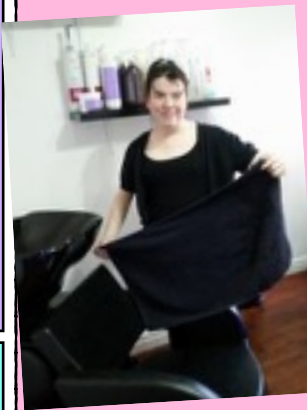
dinner and then clearing the pots away to keep the life skills area nice and clean.

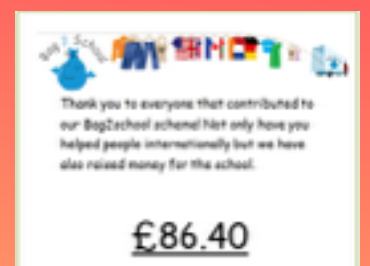


Parental Questionnaires - Can we please request that parents/carers return their questionnaires next week. Your opinions are important to us in shaping our practice. Thank you.
