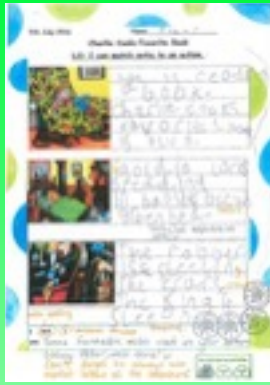
**Weekly Attendance** - Our whole school attendance target for 2015-16 is 95%. The average weekly attendance this week is **93.7%**.
